4. “Monica Bonvincini: RE pleasure RUN” at Mitchell-Innes & Nash

Berlin-based, Italian conceptual artist Monica Bonvincini gets her first New York solo show in a decade. Her debut at the gallery centers on *Structural Psychodramas #2*, an installation of small Murano glass sculptures, as well as two of the artist’s monumental disaster paintings and large-scale, provocative neon works, one of which reads “NO MORE MASTURBATION.”
