2. Monica Bonvicini at the <u>Berlinische Galerie</u>, September 16, 2017 – February 26, 2018

For her solo presentation at the Berlinische Galerie, Monica Bonvicini has produced a site-specific installation to be staged in the museum's large exhibition hall—a move that is a hallmark of her decades-long practice, which often focuses on the institutional viewing space. Because the Berlin exhibition runs in tandem with the 15th Istanbul Biennale, in which Bonvicini is <u>also</u> <u>participating</u>, the show is influenced by both Berlin and Istanbul, and is said to feature elements of each major city.
