Armory Week may emphasize art fairs and events, but it's also an opportune time to take in the best of New York's gallery and museum exhibitions. From an in-depth look at <u>Georgia O'Keeffe</u>'s finely crafted persona at the <u>Brooklyn Museum</u> to fresh figurative paintings by <u>Sascha Braunig</u> at <u>Foxy Production</u> to a new suite of <u>Sterling</u> <u>Ruby</u> ceramics at <u>Gagosian</u>, these 20 shows are not to be missed.

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<u>Bonvicini</u> addresses power dynamics, effective communication, and even the structure of the gallery itself in this new show. Central to the exhibition is *Structural Psychodramas #2* (2017), a large-scale installation of temporary walls that questions the architecture of art institutions. Neon text works, one of which reads "NO MORE MASTURBATION," offer a cheeky commentary on the role of desire in the present moment.
